Board of Education Goals

Policy & Board Knowledge Base

- Adopt a “Code of Ethics for Board Members and all District Personnel” policy and amend in accordance with Erie 1 BOCES Policy Services and NYSOSC recommendations
- Adopt a policy on water testing for lead in all school buildings and implement water testing in all buildings
- Update reserve fund policy and approve LCSD Reserve and Fund Balance Plan
- Update the community on the present state of the NYSED reform agenda (i.e. standards, assessments, APPR, and LCSD student achievement results)
- Create an alternative plan to meet the requirement of the BOE to visit each school

Student Achievement

- Support increased student achievement and success for all students, Pre-K – 12, including the expansion of opportunities in STEM studies, alternative programs, and educational technology
- Continue the exploration and establishment of an Alternative School for Lancaster students
- Review the organization of schools and boundaries

Finance / Operations

- Review impact of upcoming minimum wage increases and implement plan that charters a course for the district in the coming years
- Move Phase V and VI of the \$57.3 Million bond issue forward from planning and design to start of construction
- Create and implement the NYSOSC Financial Condition report corrective action plan
- Support and monitor the implementation of the approved Smart Schools Bond Act Plan: device purchasing and implementation, continuing professional development, preliminary planning for UPK facilities, and exploration of next generation technology applications

Health & Safety

- Develop an implementation plan for Education Law 807.1, 1-a, adding a requirement of 4 annual lockdown drills at each building
- Support and monitor the district’s efforts to create a written workplace safety plan and protocols
- Review and update the LCSD Allergy Policy and Administrative Regulations to improve safety for these students
